1. You must show in Swine Showmanship in order to receive premium monies in the Swine Show. Please check the Showmanship box on the green entry form. If you are exhibiting both Purebred swine and Market hogs, you must show in both showmanship contests to receive premium monies and be eligible for Premier Exhibitor.

RULES (continued)

2. Classes and order of show will be determined by the superintendents and posted. Each exhibitor must show their own animal.
3. Purebred Showmanship - Gilts only may be used for showmanship animals.

RULES

1. Exhibitors of Market Hogs must have ownership by June 1, 2009.
2. Each Market Hog must be ear-tagged with the official State Fair identification by July 1, 2009. Ear-tag numbers must be listed on the entry form for each exhibitor.
3. Hogs shown in purebred classes may not be shown in the Market Hog Show. Market Hogs may be of any breed and are not required to be purebred. Barrows and Gilts are eligible for the show.
4. Hogs must be farrowed on or after February 1, 2009.
- NEW!** 5. Hogs weighing over 295 pounds or under 225 pounds will not be eligible for the show. If there is any question concerning the actual weight, the hog must be re-weighed immediately before it is taken back to the barn. See rule 15.
6. Junior exhibitors will be limited to two entries in the show. Classes will be made up after hogs are weighed.
- NEW!** 7. It is strongly recommended that market hogs not be skin clipped.
8. The 2009 Junior Show for market animals selected as Grand and Reserve Grand Champions will be a terminal show. This means that all Grand and Reserve Grand Champions must be harvested. There are two options:
 - A) The youth may elect to consign their animal to the Greenbrier/Monroe Livestock Association, Inc. Sale. After the animal is sold the State Fair will assume responsibility for the animal and deliver it to a designated State or Federally inspected slaughter facility;
 - B) At release time, the State Fair will assume responsibility for the animal and deliver it to a designated State or Federally inspected slaughter facility. After harvest the youth will be able to pick up the carcass to do with as they prefer.All Grand and Reserve Grand Champions will have a blood sample drawn immediately upon completion of the class. This sample will be sent to an independent lab for drug screening.
9. If, at the market hog check-in time, a concern regarding identification arises, the situation will be handled by the Dept. F General Superintendents and the State Fair Executive Committee.
10. Self waters cannot be more than 12 inches above the top of the sides of the pen.

5. All animals entered in the Purebred Swine Classes must be registered in the recognized American herd books of their respective breeds.
