RULES PERTAINING TO THE DAIRY GOAT SHOW

NEW! 1. In order to enable the widest exhibitor participation, initial entries will be restricted to fifty (50) animals from one family or animals housed on the same farm. Immediate family members who hold memberships in the American Dairy Goat Association are considered as one family and one exhibitor. Example: husband, wife and child membership that would count as three exhibitors in ADGA would count as one family with a limit of 50 animals that could be entered in the State Fair of West Virginia. If initial entries do not fill the space allotted to goats, a mailing will be sent to all exhibitors offering more space. However, if initial entries with the 50 head per family limitation exceed the allotted space, the entries will be accepted on a first come-first served basis. Housing for the dairy goats will be in the Goat/Swine Barn in pens (approximately 5' x 6') that have vertical bars.

Department G - Boer Goats

RULES PERTAINING TO THE BOER GOAT SHOW

1. All goats must be registered in the herdbook of recognized association before the day of the show. Recognized associations include American Boer Goat Association, International Boer Goat Association, USBGA and the Canadian Boer Goat Association. Original registration certificates are required, though a copy of a Registration Application, stamped with the date received by one of the listed associations, can be accepted for kids less than three (3) months of age. Animals must be registered in the name of the exhibitor and must have been owned by the exhibitor on or before the date of the show. Throughout the ABGA and JABGA show rules the term exhibitor is defined as the owner of the animal listed in the ABGA registry shown on the entry deadline. **All goats must be appropriately identified and comply with USDA Scrapie Eradication Program Guidelines. Call 1-866-USDA TAG (873-2824) or visit the following website for more information, http://www.aphis.usda.gov/animal_health/animal_disease/scrapie/.**
2. All goats must have legible tattoos or other means of permanent identification consistent with its registration certificate or the animal will be disqualified. Point winners from each class must have their tattoos read and recorded. The judge will be responsible for ensuring that the tattoos are read and properly recorded. The show secretary will be responsible for recording the tattoos and informing the judge as to which goats will need to be checked. If the animal has a microchip as its permanent identification, the exhibitor is responsible for providing a microchip reader.
3. Goats entered under their ABGA registration number and presenting their ABGA Certificates of Registration will be eligible to earn points for their actual placing in the show as described in the ABGA "Criteria for Ennoblement of a Boer Goat."
4. Birthdates, as listed on the registration certificate, will be used to determine the class divisions. Take the show date and count back to the birth date to determine the age and the class for the animal.
5. All animals must be registered purebred, fullblood or percentage blood Boer goats. Percentage doe classes are for goats 50% to 88%, Purebred/Fullblood classes are for does that are 93.75% and higher, 96.87% and higher for bucks. Bucks 96.86% and lower are not eligible to be shown. Progeny of fresh does will not be allowed in the ring. At the discretion of the judge and the superintendent, goats may be let loose in the ring as a function of judging. The Champion and Reserve Champion classes will be chosen from the first and second place animals in that division of the show.
6. Any goat showing any pronounced defect or abnormality will be barred from the show in any breeding classes. Artificial coloring will be a disqualification as well as illegible tattoos or tattoos that are inconsistent with the goat's registration papers. Any doe over 24 month of age that has not kidded and cannot prove a current pregnancy will not be allowed to show.
7. Goats shown in the Dept F, Junior Market Goat Show, may not show in the purebred Boer goat show.
8. **REFER TO HEALTH REGULATIONS ON PAGE 6.**
9. **No exhibitor will be paid premiums for more than the two highest places earned in any single class.**
10. The SFVW reserves the right to have any goat inspected by the Superintendent, a veterinarian of its choice, or Animal Health staff to diagnose contagious disease and to reject any unhealthy animal at any time during the fair.

59. Herdsman: In recognition of exhibitor's effort to display Boer goats in an appealing manner, the State Fair shall award a Best Herdsman. Exhibits will be judged at least two (2) times from Wednesday through 6 pm on Saturday. We will emphasize cleanliness of animals, equipment and people; sportsmanship toward other exhibitors and courtesy toward spectators; promotional value of exhibit; and spectator appeal of animals, displays and equipment. *No premium monies given.* **DO NOT ENTER THIS CLASS.**

RULES PERTAINING TO THE JUNIOR BOER GOAT SHOW

1. Exhibitors must be in accordance of the JABGA By-Laws in terms of age and be an active Junior American Boer Goat Association Member.
2. If the child is present and physically able, they must show their own animal unless they have multiple entries; then they must have another JABGA member to show the animal for them.
3. If the child is not present due to circumstances such as death in the family, family emergencies, religious reasons, etc; they must have a JABGA member show for them, and it must be reported before the goats arrive at the show. This will be allowed for two JABGA shows only.
4. JABGA members under the age of six (6), as of January 1, or members with physical or mental disabilities are allowed to have headers and heelers in the class, but the member must help in the presentation of the animal.
5. Goats must be registered in the JABGA member's name only. No ranch or family name can be listed in the owner section of the certificate.
6. If a child is caught cheating/dishonest behavior, the child will be warned and fined \$250 for the first offense. Second offense, the child and his/her siblings will not be allowed to participate in any future JABGA shows.
7. The same goat cannot be entered in two (2) different exhibitors' names in both the open and junior shows.
8. Goats shown in the Dept F, Junior Market Goat Show, may not show in the Junior American Boer goat show.
