**CONDITIONS**

Entries will be taken at 8:00 a.m. and close at 10:00 a.m. one day before each racing day. The management reserves the right to reject any entry, to declare off or rearrange programs as conditions may require.

The U.S.T.A. rules are to be used with right to use Rule No. 13, Sec. 2 (A), if necessary.

In races with more than 10 horses declared to start, we reserve the right to race in divisions or eliminations. We reserve the right to require six separate interests in each overnight event.

A horse that is scratched one day may not race the next day of racing unless approved by judge. All events to be raced one (1) heat at one (1) mile each.

Entry fees of \$10.00 for purses less than \$2,000.00. Entry fees of \$20.00 for purses of \$2,000.00 and over. All entry fees and eligibility papers must be in the racing office along with registration papers and claiming authorization before horse races.

All harness racing purses will be paid by checks which will be mailed within 10 days following the close of the fair.

**PLEASE DO NOT SHIP HORSES IN BEFORE 4:00 P.M. ON SATURDAY, AUGUST 15, 2009.**

Association not responsible for accidents, fire or theft, but will make every effort to prevent same. Upon arrival, check with Racing Superintendent for stall assignment.

**HEALTH REQUIREMENTS FOR HORSES**

From West Virginia

- (1) Must be uniquely identified **and**
- (2) Have a negative Coggins' test (from a USDA official approved laboratory) within the last 24 months.

From Other States

- (1) Must be uniquely identified
- (2) Accompanied by an approved CVI from the state of origin prior to show or fair, **and**
- (3) A negative Coggins' Test (from a USDA official approved laboratory) within the last twelve months if State has a comparable program.
- (a) Negative Coggins' Test from states with no program
