Check-In, Check-Out Times and Health Regulations:

Check in: Thurs., August 13th ~12-6pm

Check out: Sun., August 16th ~6pm

Health Requirements: Llamas from within West Virginia or Out-of-State must be free of disease.
Llamas are required to have a vet certificate of good health issued within 30 days of the show.
Veterinarian's ID number must appear on the certificate.
All health certificates will be checked at the show by our State Veterinarian upon arrival at Gate 5

Rules and Guidelines

1. Youth &/or Adult performance &/or Llama halter &/or Fleece classes may be combined if there are not enough entries in a division.
2. Stalls (12 X 10 X 5) Corral panels located inside the dairy barns South entrance adjoining the Large Livestock Indoor Show Arena. Gate 5, 1st Barn on your Left.
3. Water, Electric & PA--Straw for bedding provided. Please mark # of straw tickets you need.
4. Each exhibitor receives 1 Complimentary Admission ticket per day.
5. One complimentary "on grounds" Parking Pass per farm for Thurs., Fri., Sat. & Sun. (8-13 through 8-16).
6. Show Photographer & Overnight Security provided by State Fair of WV
7. Camping request Form www.statefairfowv.com to be mailed to Reagan Simms Rodgers; State Fair of WV, PO Box 986, Lewisburg, WV 24901. (304-645-1090) if questions.

Registration Requirements:

1. ILR Certificate is required for ALL Llamas; no pending registrations, except for NON-breeders (which must show in Adult Non-breeder class if no ILR paperwork) or llamas used in Youth Classes
2. All Non-breeders (Male or Female) MUST have either an ILR Certificate stating non-breeder status or MUST have non-breeder status stated on Vet. Health Certificate to show in Halter Division.
3. 2009 ALSA membership Card for all Youth and Adult exhibitors or enclose ALSA non-membership fee.
4. 2009 Youth exhibitors date of birth, address and phone number are required for entry
5. Llamas may only show in ONE Performance Division (llamas showing in youth may not show in Open, Novice or Adult)

Any ALSA member is eligible to enter their **llama’s** Shorn full or barrel fleece &/or **llamas** in Walking Fleece Class. The fleece show will be governed by ALSA 15th edition handbook. All llama shorn fleece entries must be on the show grounds by **5pm on Thursday, August 13th, 2009**. Entries **may be mailed in and accepted now through July 18th, 2009**. Judging will begin Thursday at 6pm and completed with fleece & awards on display Friday & Saturday during the Llama show.

The Classes are as follows: (SF=shorn or WF=walking)

- SF-1 or WF-1** Double Coat Up through 24 months
- SF-2 or WF-2** Double Coat 25 months and older
- SF-3 or WF-3** Single Coat Up through 24 months
- SF-4 or WF-4** Single Coat 25 months and older
- SF-5 or WF-5** Suri Coat up through 24 months
- SF-6 or WF-6** Suri Coat 25 months and older

Additional division of classes: at the Judge’s discretion, classes may be further divided in the following prioritized order: age at shear, color, gender. When dividing a class, the number of entries in each new class must equal or exceed 4 fleeces. Fleeces may be moved to a more suitable fiber class at Judge’s discretion.

Entry fees are **\$15 per fleece**. The State Fair of WV will return your fleece free of charge! Or pick up your fleece on Saturday, August 15th, 2009. Ribbons will be awarded to 5th place. Cash Premiums \$15, \$10, \$5, WV State Fair Banners for Grand & Reserve Champion in each division Shorn & Walking. A special award to our “Best of Show” full shorn & walking fleece.
