**IMPORTANT NOTICE:** ALL HORSES ON THE GROUNDS MUST HAVE A CURRENT NEGATIVE COGGINS WITHIN 12 MONTHS FOR OUT OF STATE HORSES AND 24 MONTHS FOR IN STATE HORSES. IN ADDITION ALL OUT OF STATE HORSES MUST HAVE A HEALTH CERTIFICATE. THIS CERTIFICATE WILL BE INSPECTED BY THE STATE VETERINARIAN. THERE WILL BE NO EXCEPTIONS. HORSES NOT IN COMPLIANCE MAY BE ASKED TO LEAVE THE PREMISES.

**EXHIBITOR PET POLICY:** Seeing eye dogs and/or service dogs needed by the disabled will be permitted. Livestock exhibitors' pets will be allowed in the various barn areas if securely confined on a leash. Pets are allowed in off-grounds parking/camping areas, but they must be either on leashes or otherwise confined at all times. Dogs are not allowed around the show ring area while the show is in session. IF THIS POLICY IS NOT FOLLOWED THE FAIR WILL ONCE AGAIN RESTRICT PETS ENTIRELY FROM THE HORSE SHOW.

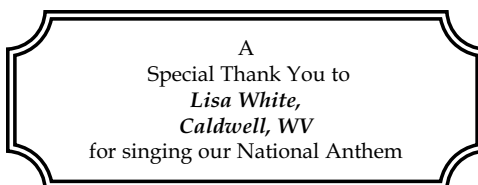

**SPECIAL NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS**

Two (2) gate tickets, per horse, per day, entered will be issued. Additional gate tickets may be purchased from the State Fair Box Office until August 10 (1-800-585-3737) or at designated BB&T Bank locations July 1 through August 10. Prices: \$7.00 per adult pass (ages 13 & older), \$5.00 per youth (ages 6-12) Passes purchased at the gate August 14-22: \$10.00 per adult and \$7.00 per youth. Children 5 years old and under are admitted free. Tickets may also be ordered online at [www.statefairfwv.com](http://www.statefairfwv.com) Lost passes will be the responsibility of the exhibitor. Gate tickets do not include parking. Credentials are mailed to the agent specified on the entry form. Agents are responsible for distributing credentials prior to the fair.

**RULES AND REGULATIONS**

**HORSES HAVE THE RIGHT OF WAY AT ALL TIMES.**

**PROTECTIVE HEADGEAR IS ALLOWED IN ALL CLASSES.**

SECRETARIES' OFFICE WILL BE OPEN 9:00 A.M. UNTIL 11:30 A.M. EACH DAY DURING HARNESS RACING. OFFICE WILL REOPEN SHORTLY AFTER LAST RACE AND WILL STAY OPEN UNTIL ONE HOUR PRIOR TO THE SCHEDULED START OF THE SESSION.

A BLANK CHECK AT THIS TIME IS NOT ACCEPTABLE. OPEN CHECK POLICY WILL BE IN EFFECT ON AUGUST 10, 2009.

**1. ENTRIES:** Entries must be postmarked (U.S. Postal Service Mark) by July 7, 2009. Any entry received postmarked after this date will be considered a Post Entry. Any entry received without payment in full will be considered a Post Entry. Stall reservations will not be honored without payment in full for entries.

Entry blanks MUST be signed by an adult. Parent, guardian, agent or trainer must sign for minors.

Every class offered herein which is covered by the rules and specifications of the current US Equestrian Federation Incorporation, West Virginia Horseman Association, National Horse Show Commission, and Appalachian Horse Show Association rules will be conducted and judged in accordance therewith. However, the Horse Show Manager's decision is final and is not protestable. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to submit entries that do not constitute a violation of these provisions. Ponies may not cross enter into horse classes and vice versa.

**2. LATE ENTRY PENALTY RULES:** Entries close July 7, 2009. All entries postmarked later than this date will be accepted at the regular fee plus \$20.00 per horse post entry penalty. The date is according to the U.S. postal postmark, not a metered postmark. To receive credit for totally scratched horses, you must present a veterinarian certificate on official letterhead. This certificate must be received prior to the end of the horse show.

All monies, except stall fees, will be refunded if the horse show office is notified before August 14, 2009, for the first session; August 17, 2009, for the second session, for any cancelled horses except for a \$15.00 scratch horse fee per horse, parking passes, and any late entry fees. Late penalty will not be charged for added classes for horses already entered in the show up to one hour before the scheduled start of each session. All classes entered after one hour before the scheduled start of the session will be charged a session late entry penalty of \$15.00 per class. Classes scratched within this period will not be refunded.

**3. TRANSFER OF ENTRY FEES:** Exhibitor may transfer entry fees from one class to another when completed with show secretary one (1) hour prior to session involved. Show Management will permit an exhibitor to enter another horse; however, the new entry must be given another number. Legal proof of sale, designating the name and address of the purchaser will be required. Post Penalty Fees on a substitute horse will be waived provided entries are made within the established time limits. Stall fees will not be refunded. Refunds will **NOT** be paid during the show. Refunds/premium money will be mailed within thirty (30) days after the close of the State Fair of West Virginia.

**4. STALLS:** ENTRIES WISHING TO BE STALLED TOGETHER SHOULD BE MAILED IN THE SAME ENVELOPE. TACK STALLS ARE NOT GUARANTEED. TACK STALLS ARE BASED ON AVAILABILITY. We will make every attempt to fulfill stall requests. However, stall assignments are based on the number of stalls and availability. Specific stall requests cannot always be fulfilled. Exhibitors are encouraged to only reserve stalls for their animals showing in the current session. Should stall availability become a problem, those entries with animals not entered in that session may be required to move the animals to a different location or not be allowed in a stall until their showing session. ALL FEES MUST ACCOMPANY ENTRIES TO BE ASSURED OF STABLING. The Fair will charge \$100.00 if stall doors (tops or bottoms) have been removed or altered and are not put back in their original condition. All horses with stalls must show or will be assessed a fee of \$80.00 in addition to the price of the stall. Stalls are covered box stalls with two section doors in most.

Tack Stall Fee - \$85.00.

Stall Fee - Thursday 9:00 A.M. until Monday  
8:00 A.M. - \$60.00.

Stall Fee - Monday - 10:00 A.M. until Thursday  
8:00 A.M. - \$60.00.

ALL HORSES MUST VACATE BY THURSDAY 8:00 A.M. TO ALLOW STALL CLEANING FOR THE WEST VIRGINIA 4-H JUNIOR HORSE AND PONY SHOW.

**5. PREMIUMS:** Classes with less than three (3) entries may receive one half of premium money. Premiums won will be applied to the show bill. PREMIUMS WILL BE PAID BY CHECK TO THE PERSON DESIGNATED ON THE ENTRY BLANK AS AGENT. Check will be mailed within 30 days after the close of the State Fair of West Virginia. Attempts will not be made by Show Management to obtain addresses which are not complete, legible, or correct on the entry blank. Premiums may not be mailed if agent fails to provide proper social security number.

**6. PARKING PERMITS:** ONE (1) Parking Permit for cars and trucks may be purchased when making entries for each Horse Owner (and Trainer if different from Owner). Parking permits are \$20.00 each and will be limited to the three days of each session and are valid for the period indicated thereon. These permits are NON-RETURNABLE AND NON-REFUNDABLE. Such permit must be firmly affixed to the rear view mirror. Vehicles that do not have a permit affixed to the rear view mirror will be towed at the owner's expense. The fair will not attempt to locate the

owner before towing.

SHIP-INS MAY NOT ORDER PARKING PASSES as there is limited space in the infield. A parking pass is for the vehicle only. It does not gain admittance for the driver nor for the passengers. You must purchase extra gate passes when needed. Draft Horses stabled in the Draft Horse Barn are not eligible for parking passes. Parking will also be limited to the amount of parking spaces available at each area. (Refer to map on inside back cover for designated area near your stable.) Neither horse trailers, vans nor campers will be allowed to park in the areas designated as car parking areas. Tents are not allowed in parking areas. When passes are exhausted, no more will be issued.

FREE auxiliary parking will be available in the general fair parking lot. Vehicles without valid parking permits or left in an area not designated as Horse Show Parking area will be towed away at owner's expense. Exhibitors with horses enter through Gate 5 - Livestock Gate on Route 219 North.

**7. CAMPERS:** The fair does not guarantee power for the campers. Fifty (50) camper spaces will be available on a first come, first served basis at a cost of \$75.00 each per session. Campers will not be allowed to park in any area other than that designated as camping area. Camping is not allowed around Barn 12. NO EXCEPTIONS. The grounds surrounding the camper spaces are not to be used as a toilet area under any circumstances. The fair has sufficient and clean restrooms for all to use. Each camper parked on the grounds must display a fair permit. Campers entering the fairgrounds must have a permit in their possession and MUST VACATE the grounds by 8:00 A.M. on Monday for the first session and 8:00 A.M. on Thursday for the second session. DUE TO SPACE LIMITATION, AWNINGS WILL NOT BE ALLOWED. All tents must pay a camping fee and are only allowed in the camping area.

FREE CAMPING AND PARKING are located across the street from the Fairgrounds. Call (304) 645-1090 for more information on free camping & parking.

**8. NOVICE HORSE OR NOVICE RIDER** can not have won three blue ribbons in the division they are showing in at the State Fair of West Virginia. Wins in driving do not affect status in under saddle and vice versa. Wins are only counted for State Fair of West Virginia, not other shows.

**9. RESERVATIONS:** Management reserves the right to:

- a.) add to or vary the list of invited officials.
- b.) cancel or combine any class with fewer than four (4) entries.
- c.) refuse and return any or all entries without explanation or recourse to the State Fair of West Virginia.
- d.) bar from the ring any rider, driver or attendant not properly attired or if it is in the best interest to the Horse Show.
- e.) bar from the grounds any exhibitor or his employees who refuse to follow any of the rules of this Horse Show or the the rules the State Fair of West Virginia.

**10. SHIP-IN PARKING & PASSES: ALL ENTRIES INCLUDING SHIP-INS MUST BE PRE-REGISTERED. NO ONE WILL BE ALLOWED ON THE FAIRGROUNDS WITHOUT A STABLE OR SHIP-IN PASS.** A one-day ship-in parking pass (\$15.00 per horse/per day) will be issued to entries not obtaining stalls. This pass will be good only on the day the horse is showing. Ship-ins must be vacated within 1/2 (one- half) hour following the completion of their last class. Ship-ins will not be allowed to stay overnight on the fairgrounds. Only two gate passes per horse per day will be allowed with each horse shipped-in. All others must pay admission.

DUE TO HARNESS RACING, SHIP-IN'S ARE NOT ALLOWED TO ENTER BEFORE 4:00 P.M. MON. THROUGH WED. THIS WILL BE ENFORCED.

**11. CONDUCT:** Any exhibitor, his agent or employee acting in a manner deemed improper or unsportsmanlike or using language deemed unfit or improper will be eliminated from further competition, ejected from the fairgrounds and will forfeit all fees paid and premiums won.

Upon the discovery of an aberrant act or unseemly behavior (including the consumption of alcoholic spirits) on the part of any exhibitor, owner, trainer, groom or agent in the barn and in public view, the Board of Directors, if such act is proven to their satisfaction, reserves the right to withhold the payment of any prizes awarded, to prohibit any such party or parties from exhibiting for one or more years, to publish the names of any such person or persons as may be deemed expedient, and to award a prize or prizes so withheld as though such exhibitor or exhibitors had not exhibited.

**12. HEALTH REGULATIONS:** It is required by management that each horse possess a current Negative Coggins Test. A copy must be attached to the entry blank. If the show office has to make a copy for our file, there will be a \$1.00 per page fee charged.

**WEST VIRGINIA** - Negative Coggins Test within the last 24 months.

**OTHER STATES** - Approved official health certificate from the state of origin and Negative Coggins Test within the last 12 months. These will be inspected by the State Veterinarian.

**It is recommended by the State Veterinarian that all horses have the following vaccines prior to the horse show:**

**1.) Tetnus Toxioid, 2.) Eastern/Western Equine Encephalitis, 3.) West Nile Virus, 4.) Influenza, and 5.) Rabies.**

**NOTE: Animals from any herd or herds under restrictions will not be permitted to show. Animal Health Officials of the West Virginia Department of Agriculture reserve the right to examine any animal consigned, and exclude animals from the show that exhibit signs of disease.**

**13. OFF-ROAD VEHICLES:**

Golf carts and scooters will be allowed in the horse show and stable area. There will be strict rules regarding these vehicles. They may only be driven by a licensed driver, and a fair issued permit must be displayed at all time. Golf carts are ONLY allowed in the horse show and horse show stable area. The show office will give you a map showing designated areas. Anyone not following these rules will be subject to expulsion from the show grounds and will relinquish all claims for reimbursement of fees paid and will be issued a fine. ATV's, bicycles, skateboards, etc. are not allowed on either the main fairgrounds, the public parking/camping areas, or the horse show grounds. State Fair management reserves the privilege of having its own personnel use a limited number of service type vehicles.

**14. LUNGEING:** Lungeing of horses will not be allowed in the show arena. Lungeing shall be limited to the practice ring.

**15. VETERINARIANS:** Names and phone numbers of veterinarians on duty can be obtained at the Horse Show Office.

**16. GATE RULE:** The PA system is provided as a courtesy to exhibitors; however, should the system be malfunctioning, it is the exhibitors' responsibility to have their entries ready for showing at least 10 minutes before the scheduled time for showing. When it is found that a class is being delayed by horses not ready to perform, the competition may be closed at the order of show management. Exhibitors are given three (3) minutes in which to appear at the in-gate ready to participate. In classes in which horses compete collectively, after warning is issued, the in-gate must be closed two (2) minutes after the first horse enters the ring. Judging will not commence until the gate is closed or at the end of the two minute call.

**17. ALL HORSES** that have been properly entered, shown and judged in their qualifying classes may show back in the championship class.

**18. ALL CHALLENGE TROPHIES** must be won by the same owner three consecutive years before permanent possession, but not necessarily the same animal. All challenge and perpetual trophies will be presented in the ring, taken to the horse show office, trophy agreement will be signed by the rider, agent, owner, or trainer, then given to the responsible person, unless fair retains them.

ALL CHALLENGE AND PERPETUAL TROPHIES MUST BE RETURNED TO THE MANAGEMENT 14 DAYS BEFORE THE OPENING DATE OF THE SHOW AND MUST BE IN PRESENTABLE CONDITION, UNLESS ARRANGEMENTS HAVE BEEN MADE WITH THE HORSE SHOW MANAGEMENT. If trophies are NOT returned, a replacement fee of \$250.00 will be charged. If trophies are NOT in a clean, presentable condition, a \$25.00 fee will be charged.

**19. HORSE SHOW NUMBERS:** A number will be assigned to each horse at the time the entry is received, which number will stand for the entire State Fair Horse Show and must be displayed whenever the horse is in the ring.

**20. PRACTICE RING:** The practice ring will be available to warm up horses. All horses will cross the race track at the designated passage way. STATE FAIR POLICY DOES NOT PERMIT SHOW HORSES TO WARM-UP ON THE RACE TRACK.

**21. NON-NEGOTIABLE CHECKS:** All non-negotiable checks will incur a \$50 return check fee.

**22. PRIOR TO DEPARTURE:** All accounts must be settled and no animals will be permitted to leave the show grounds without an official release form from the show office.

**23. ENTRY AGREEMENT:** by entering this competition and signing this entry blank as the Owner, Lessee, Trainer, Manager, Agent, Coach, Driver, Rider, Handler, or Longeur and on behalf of myself and my principals, representatives, employees and agents, I agree to release and hold harmless the competition, their officials, directors, and employees for any action taken under their rules. I represent that I am eligible to enter and/or participate and every horse I am entering is eligible as entered. I also agree that as a condition of and in consideration of acceptance of entry, the State Fair of West Virginia and/or the competition may use or assign photographs, videos, audios, cablecasts, or other likeness of me and/or my horse taken during the course of the competition for the promotion, coverage or benefit of the competition or the State Fair of WV. I hereby expressly and irrevocably waive and release any rights in connection with such use, including compensation, invasion of privacy, right of publicity, or to misappropriation.

**24. NEITHER THE STATE FAIR OF WEST VIRGINIA, NOR THE MANAGEMENT, NOR THE SHOW OFFICIALS ARE TO BE HELD RESPONSIBLE FOR ANY LOSS OR DAMAGE THAT MIGHT OCCUR, AND IT WILL BE THE CONDITION OF THE ENTRY THAT EACH EXHIBITOR SHALL HOLD THE HORSE SHOW AND ITS MANAGEMENT BLAMELESS FOR ANY LOSS OR ACCIDENT TO ANY ANIMAL, PERSON OR PROPERTY THAT MAY OCCUR FROM SICKNESS, FIRE AND OTHERWISE AT THIS SHOW.**

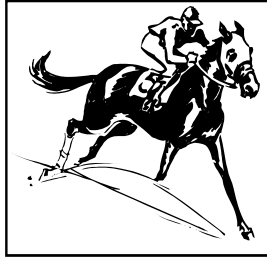

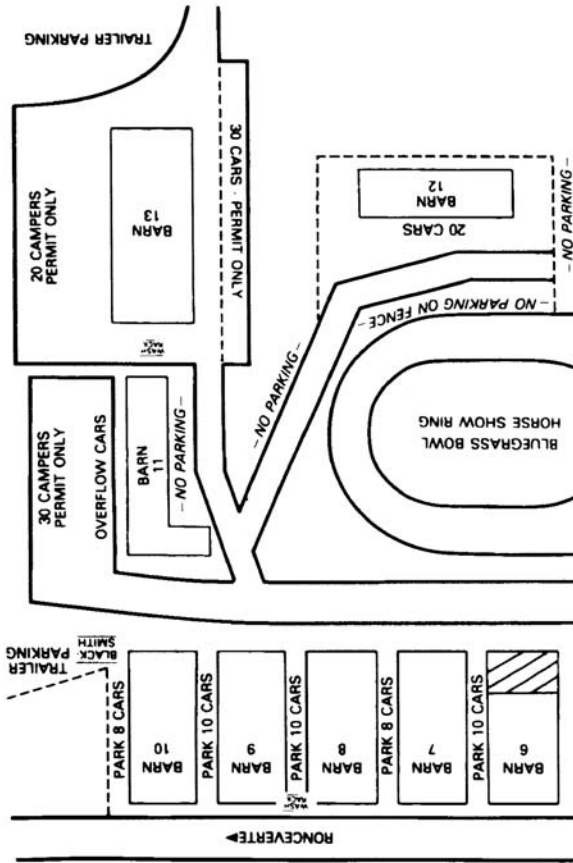

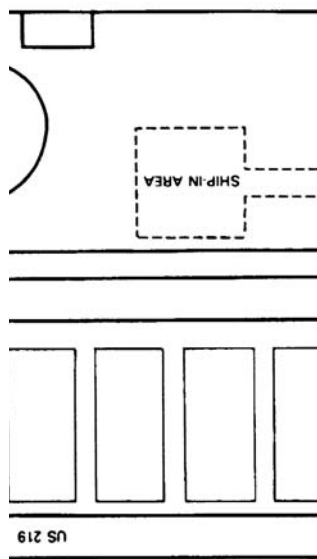
